TERRITORIAL ACCESS TO INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY (ATIPP) OFFICE SUPPLIMENTAL NOTES REVIEW REPORT: 21-198

FOR: The Nunavut Arctic College

- **PURPOSE:** The Territorial ATIPP Office recognizes that the Information and Privacy Commissioner's Review Reports often contain recommendations that serve more than solely the responding department. These notes are intended to support the responding department by discussing Government of Nunavut wide implications and the next steps.
- DATE: July 30, 2021

This office notes NAC has accepted the recommendation of the IPC in full. This office also notes that NAC did internally ensure the discretionary redactions applied were done with the appropriate level of consideration and consultations. Relaying the resulting reasoning behind the redactions in a clear, coherent, but simple way to applicants is the next step – one that needs to be improved GN wide.

Applicants are mainly informed of a public body's use of discretion with an exemption rationale document that accompanies each release. The Territorial ATIPP Office will work with the public bodies, through the ACC, to continually optimize this document and internal processing until an acceptable standard is met.

To this end and with the IPC's recommendations, the ATIPP Coordinators Committee has updated the rationale template as of the July 27, 2021 meeting. This office and the ACC will monitor the effectiveness of these changes and make adjustments as necessary.
